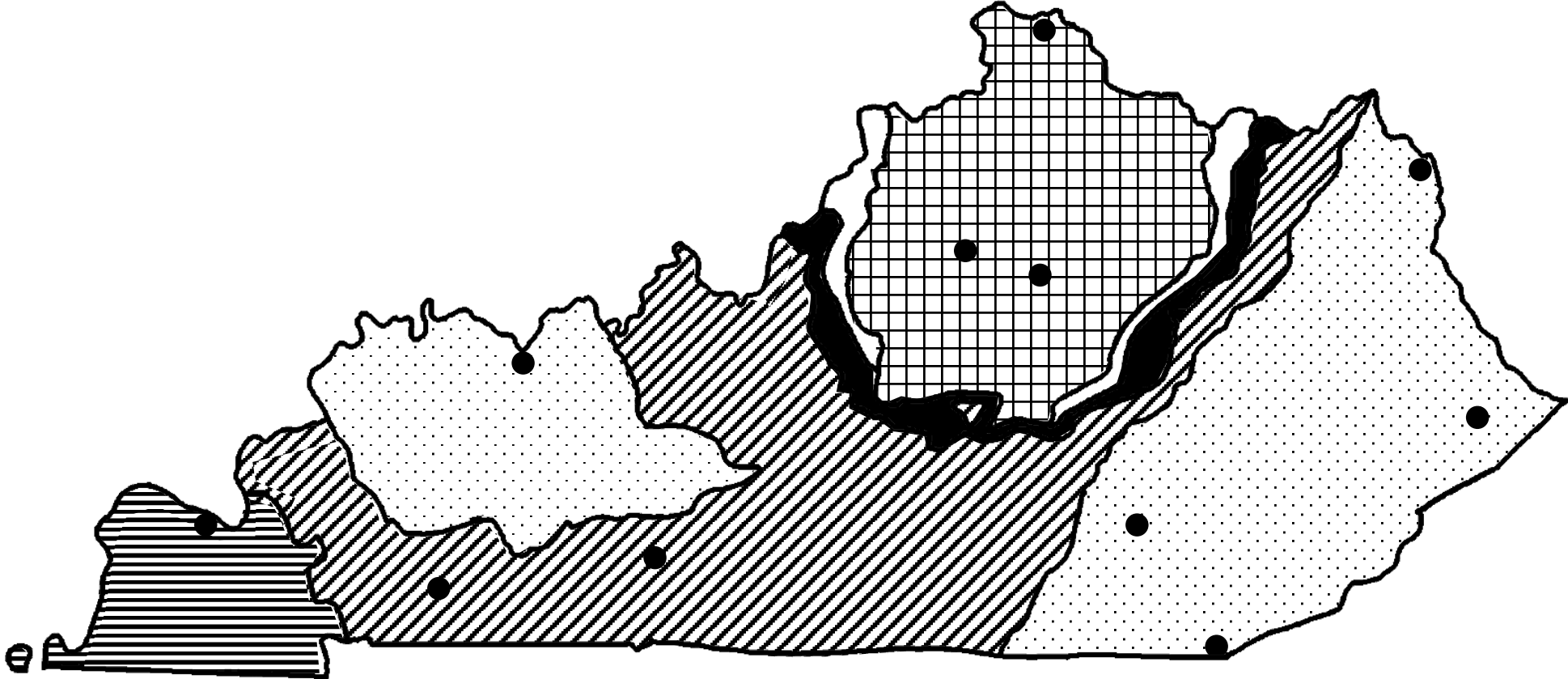
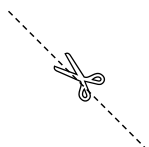


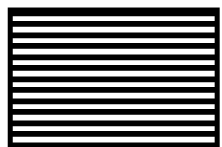
Geologic Map of Kentucky



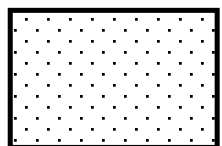

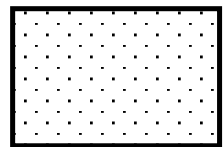

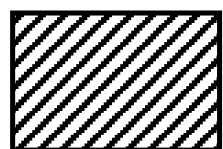

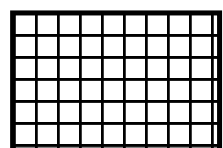

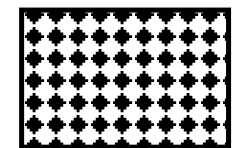

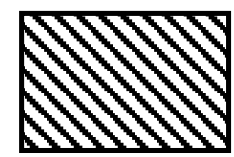
